

Executive Board meeting 13 June 2022

Summary of outcomes

The Chair of the Executive Board, Mr Ladislav Hamran, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the fourteenth meeting in 2022 of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main discussions

The Executive Board reviewed the draft Consolidated Annual Activity Report (CAAR) 2021 and the draft College assessment of the CAAR 2021.

The Executive Board adopted its opinion on the final annual accounts of Eurojust for the financial year 2021.

The Executive Board adopted an Executive Board Decision laying down general implementing provisions on the conduct of administrative inquiries and disciplinary proceedings based on a Commission model decision for decentralised agencies and joint undertakings.

The Executive Board discussed the evaluation of the format and organisation of Consultative Forum meetings and possible follow-up activities.

The Executive Board decided to decline the request to participate in a study on 'Ndrangheta's subversive power in the Netherlands.
